A MESSAGE FROM OUR CEO Susan Greenbaum



When I sit to write this letter every year, my thoughts are normally catapulted onto a journey about our staff and their successes; our programs and services and their growing impact on our community; and our leadership and donors who light our way and enable us to do the critical work we are so passionate about.

This year, sadly, this task feels different as its unfolding has been like no other. Yet another unimaginably tragic era for the global Jewish community has once again redefined our role at JFCS as healers, supporters, facilitators of solutions, and teachers and coaches of resilience and survival. Following October 7th, we triaged cases and situations of Israeli families temporarily re-settling in our community, dual citizen older adults with medical

needs suddenly returning to America after decades, traumatized local families and individuals, parents and families of IDF soldiers, and even continuing psychotherapy across six thousand miles because soldiers returned to serve.

It is overwhelming to think about the layers of new challenges above and beyond the norm, yet our JFCS staff team continues to innovate and address glaring mental health and social service needs in our community with creativity and grit. As you read these pages, please note the new RAISE Program, whose first cohort will complete their training in October. In May, JFCS was awarded the 2024 Program Impact Award by our Network of Jewish Human Agencies for our original groupwork curriculum for children and adolescents, 'Be Your Best Self ™". This program has allowed us to be comprehensively integrated with our local Jewish Day Schools, addressing the needs of the children in our community. We are also completing our first formal year providing social work support to the staff at the Kaplen JCC. Through all four pillars of service, our impact is growing.

None of this would be possible without the strong leadership of our Board of Directors, with Sima Kern at the helm. Together with your confidence and investment in our work, you help to strengthen our staff's commitment to our community. We are eminently beginning to work on our next Strategic Plan, which will guide us for the coming three to five years. We are humbled by the mission and vision we work to attain each day and will always embrace the next challenge as needs grow and change.

We are eternally grateful to our donors and funders who empower us to empower others!

Program Success: Helping Our Children With Anxiety

We began treating a high school-aged girl whose anxiety spiked due to her older brother and cousin serving in the IDF. She explained how she constantly worries for their safety and feels powerless to do anything to help them. This anxiety makes it difficult for her to interact with her friends, concentrate on school, and lead a healthy teenage life. Through individual therapy as well as sessions that included her parents, this teenager has learned techniques to manage her anxiety rather than letting it control her. Her parents were thankful for the tools we gave them and they felt supported and better equipped to manage both their daughter's and their own anxiety.

Program Success: A Little Support Goes a Long Way

A father of two young children was having trouble finding steady work since he was laid off during Covid. Being unemployed or underemployed for the better part of two years took a major toll on his self-confidence and will to improve his situation. When he came to JFCS for help, our Re-Launch advisor immediately helped him improve his resume and coached him on how to identify appropriate open positions. He found that the interview skills he learned were really useful and believes that is what made him stand out when he recently landed a new job. The thing that stayed with him the most was how much his Re-Launch advisor cared about him and his goals. That is what gave him the confidence to persevere through what is usually a very tough experience.

In its first year operating the RAISE program, JFCS has placed **4 Adults** with developmental disabilities across **8** different paid work opportunities





The RAISE program includes social skills training **Once Per Week** and guidance in transition to full employment.

Each RAISE participant is a JFCS employee and earns **\$15/hr** while working **Two 3-hour** jobs per week. The program also has **12 Volunteer** job coaches that work alongside their designated RAISE participants.


